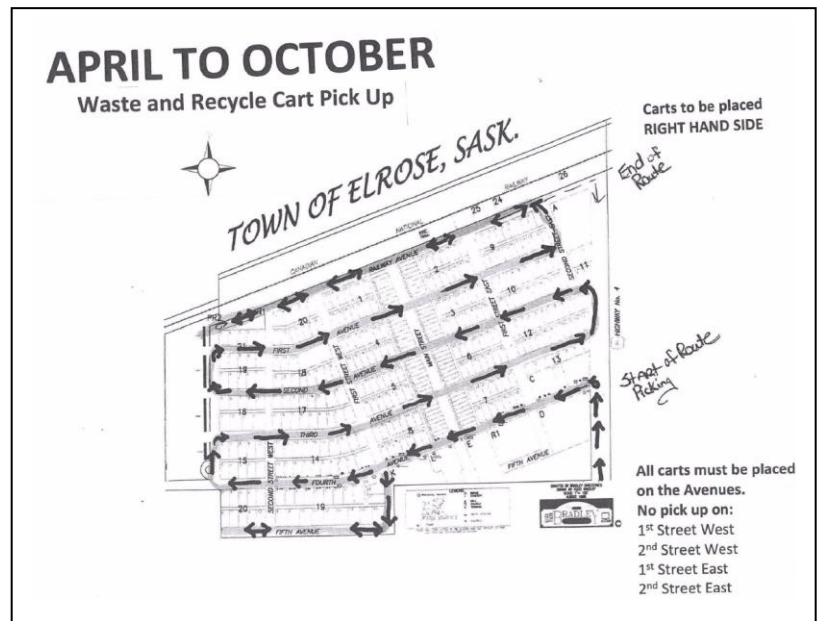

### **Reminder: Triways Waste and Recycle Cart Pick Up – April to October**

Beginning APRIL 3<sup>rd</sup> through October we will be changing to ONE SIDE pick up, see map showing the route that Triways Disposal Services will be taking with arrows indicate the direction the driver will travel, please place carts on the drivers **RIGHT HAND** side of the street and place them 10 feet from center of the street. Carts that are not placed out far enough will NOT be picked up. During this period there will be no pick up on 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Street West or 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Street East, if you are currently placing your carts on these streets please move them to the Avenue (or closest place on route) for pick up. **Main Street Alley pick up will remain the same.**

## SaskTel infiNET

SaskTel has announced that they are planning on bring SaskTel infiNET service to Elrose as part of the sixth phase of Rural Fibre Initiative.

They plan to invest \$200 million to bring this service into more than 130 communities across Saskatchewan, which will reach approximately 80% of all households in the province. SaskTel will begin construction to the communities in the sixth phase in 2023/24 and plan to have everywhere fibre ready by March 2025.
