🔧 2024 Paving project facts and info:

With all of the paving work being completed around Elrose, Council would like to again share some information about the work.

Since 2016, the Town of Elrose has reduced the street repair/patching budget and has been driving towards full resurfacing projects such as this.

The streets selected for resurfacing were chosen based on them being access points for the community. These streets have all had water main valve replacements completed, and have had sewer main inspections and repairs completed.

Total 2024 surfacing budget: \$640,000

Coming from:

Streets Reserve: \$360,000

Accumulated surplus: \$200,000

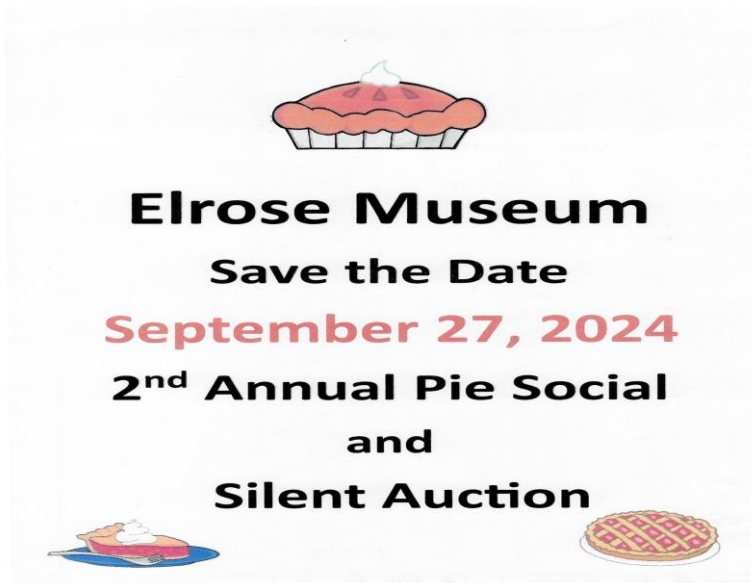
General revenue: \$ 80,000

As with any project, we can expect the unexpected, and there may be cost overruns due to unforeseen issues that could arise. There are still reserve funds that could be drawn from to cover these types of issues.

Main street and 4th Avenue resurfacing was budgeted for in 2023 but the work was not completed, rolling the funds over into the reserve account.

Resurfacing of 2nd and 3rd Avenue from Main to Hwy #4 was in the Public Works Annual Plan as budgeted for 2025, and 2026. These streets were added to the current project using Accumulated Surplus in order to utilize volume savings and complete the work prior to Homecoming 2025.

Facts to Know

- A property owner/home owner is responsible for maintaining the property they own whether they live there or not.
- If you have a vacant property it must also be maintained.
- If you own a rental property the onus falls on the owner to ensure the property is properly maintained.
- Any boulevard or back lane area maintenance is the responsibility of the property owner.
