

TOWN OF ELROSE

BYLAW 207 - 1983

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ELROSE IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS THE ELROSE BRICK SCHOOL AND LOCATED AT FOURTH AVENUE EAST AS BEING OF HISTORICAL NATURE.

WHEREAS part 111 of The Heritage Property Act, 1980 authorizes the council of a municipality to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of historical value or interest;

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Elrose has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the Elrose Brick School at Fourth Avenue East a Notice of Intention to so designate the the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least two issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least twenty one (21) days prior to the date of consideration of the Bylaw and with the last publication at least seven (7) days prior to the date of that consideration

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Elrose enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of Historical value or interest the real property known as the Elrose Brick School at Fourth Avenue East and legally described as Public Reserve : R1 Plan X2352.
2. The significance of the site is as follows
 - Promote Heritage Activity
 - Operate a Museum
3. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this Bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.
4. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this Bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister of Culture and Youth, and to cause notice of the passing of this Bylaw.
