BYLAW 216-1986

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS.

The Council of the Town of Elrose, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the Municipality.
2. Section 3 and 4 applies only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the Municipality, passed by authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000 and costs for every offense.
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000 and costs for every offense.
5. Bylaw # 76-1952 is hereby repealed.
