BYLAW #1 – 2011

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO 6 – 2005 RESPECTING THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND CONTROLLING THE REGULATING OF THE DISCHARGE OF SEWAGE INTO THE MUNICIPALITIES' SEWAGE SYSTEM:

The Council of the Town of Elrose, in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Section 10 is repealed and the following substituted therefore:

If an account is not paid by the 15th day of the next month after an arrears period of two months or 62 days, whichever is less, the water service shall be cut off. When the water service is cut off, it shall not be resumed until all arrears have been paid, together with a reconnection fee of \$100.00. If the reconnection to re-instate the said service is at a time other than the municipal employee's regular working hours, the reconnection fee shall be \$100.00 plus the minimum three hours overtime pay.


Bylaw No 6-2005 is hereby ^{amended} ~~repealed~~.
This Bylaw shall take effect on January 11, 2011.

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO 221-1986**

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO 221-1986
RESPECTING THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF
THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND CONTROLLING AND
REGULATING THE DISCHARGE OF SEWAGE INTO THE
MUNICIPALITIES SEWAGE SYSTEM:

The council of the Town of Elrose enacts as follows:

1. Section 10 is repealed and the following substituted therefore:

If an account is not paid within the said period of 110 days, the water service shall be cut off. When the water service is so cut off, it shall not be resumed until all arrears have been paid together with a reconnection fee of \$60.00.

If the reconnection to reinstate the said service is at a time other than the municipal employee's regular working hours, the reconnection fee shall be \$60.00 plus minimum 3 hours overtime pay.

BYLAW 221 - 1986


A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE MUNICIPALITY'S WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND CONTROLLING AND REGULATING THE DISCHARGE OF SEWAGE INTO THE MUNICIPALITY'S SEWAGE SYSTEM.

The Council of the Town of Elrose, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. This bylaw shall be cited as "The Water and Sewer Management Bylaw".
2. In this bylaw, including this section;
 - (a) "Municipality" means the Town of Elrose;
 - (b) "Clerk" means the Clerk/Administrator of the Municipality.
3. Persons who want to be supplied with water from the municipal system must make application to the clerk of the municipality.
4. Each application shall be accompanied by a payment of a water meter deposit in the sum of \$ 60.00.
5. The water meter deposit shall be refunded upon service being discontinued at the request, by customer, provided all water usage charges are paid in full.
6. The municipality shall have the right to limit the amount of water furnished to any customer, should circumstances seem to warrant such action.
7. No person shall convey, sell, dispose of or give away or permit water to be carried or taken away or use it or supply it for the use or benefit of others.
8. (a) No person shall discharge into any drain, sewer or sewage system operated by the municipality of a harmful matter, substance or thing, whether liquid or solid, that would be injurious to health, life or property or that would injure, pollute or damage any stream, watercourse, drain, sewer, sewerage system, or sewage treatment plant.

(b) The service of any person who contravenes this section of the bylaw shall be discontinued and shall be guilty of an offence and liable upon summary conviction to penalties provided under the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
9. Accounts for water service and/or sewer service shall cover a period of 3 successive months.
10. If an account is not paid within the said period of 110 days, the water service shall be cut off. When the water service is so cut off, it shall not be resumed until all arrears have been paid together with a reconnection fee of \$7.50. If the reconnection to reinstate the said service is at a time other than the municipal employees' regular working hours, the reconnection fee shall be \$20.00.
11. If any rates, charges or rent in arrears remain unpaid on December 31, that amount shall be added to, and thereby form part of the taxes on the land or buildings with respect to which the service was provided at the discretion of Council of the municipality.
12. Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw for which no other penalty is provided shall be guilty of an offense and liable upon summary conviction to penalties provided under the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.

13. Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Bylaw # 149-1971 are hereby repealed.


