BYLAW 239 - 1991

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION.

The Council of the Urban municipality of the Town of Elrose in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Council shall establish an emergency measures organization to deal with any emergency or disaster that may occur.
2. The Organization shall consist of two branches:
 - (a) The Executive Committee which shall consist of the Council of the Town of Elrose. This committee shall establish policy for the Emergency Measures Organization and appoint a Co-ordinator of the organization.
 - (b) The Planning Committee shall consist of officers of the municipality of the Town of Elrose and such other persons as deemed necessary. The Planning Committee, under the chairmanship of the Co-ordinator, shall formulate a municipal emergency plan.
3. The Municipality of the Town of Elrose shall provide funding as deemed necessary and appropriate in the establishment and maintenance of the Emergency Measures Organization.
4. The Council may co-operate with Councils of other municipalities for the purpose of jointly establishing and operating a Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Organization.
