BYLAW #272 - 1999

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP TIRES

The Council of the Town of Elrose in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That it is unlawful to deposit scrap tires in the municipal owned or operated landfill located within the boundaries of the Municipality.
2. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires on any other municipal property unless specifically designated as a tire marshalling yard.
3. A person who contravenes the provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00 and costs for every offense.
4. Any Corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality passed by authority of the Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 and costs for every offense.


