

TOWN OF ELROSE

BYLAW #01 - 2001

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ELROSE IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF TAXES AND PENALTIES FOR THE NON PAYMENT OF TAXES.

The Council of the Town of Elrose enacts as follows:

A discount shall be allowed on current taxes as follows:

A discount of five percent (5%) shall be allowed on current taxes paid before the first day of July.

A discount of three percent (3%) shall be allowed on current taxes paid during the months of July, August and September.


If any taxes remain unpaid after the thirty first day of December of the year in which the same are imposed there shall be added thereto by way of penalty a sum equal to ten (10%) of the arrears and upon expiry of each succeeding year during which the whole or any portion of the combined amount of taxes and penalty or penalties, remain unpaid, an additional sum equal to ten percent (10%) of such combined amount shall be added thereto.

Amounts so added shall form part of the taxes.

Nothing contained in this section shall in any way impair the right of distress or any other procedure, provided by the Urban Municipality Act, 1984 for collection thereof.

Bylaw Number 180 - 1977 is hereby repealed.

This Bylaw shall come into force on the date of final passing thereof.
