BYLAW #2 - 2005

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH ASSESSMENT APPEAL FEES

The council of the Town of Elrose, in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Under the authority of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984, subsection 251(7) the Town of Elrose hereby establishes a fee for the hearing of an assessment appeal in the amount of ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00).
2. Where an assessment appeal is successful in whole or in part on an assessment or classification appeal at either the municipal Board of Revision or the Saskatchewan Municipal Government Appeal Board, the assessment appeal fee of ONE HUNDRED (\$100.00) shall be refunded to the Appellant.
3. This bylaw shall come into effect on the date of final approval by council.
4. Bylaw # 253 - 1997 is hereby repealed.
