**BYLAW #3 – 2015**


**A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER**

The Council of the Town of Elrose in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
  - a) "Council" means the Council of the Town of Elrose; and
  - b) "Municipality" means the Town of Elrose.
2. Council hereby appoints Philip Brown as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
3. The appointment shall commence on July 9, 2015 and shall continue at the pleasure of the council.
4. The appointment may be terminated by the Town of Elrose giving 30 days written notice to the other party in the event that the service is no longer required, or the service provided is no longer satisfactory.
5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Office shall be:
  - a) to enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality,
  - b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
  - c) and other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate.
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on September 8, 2015.


Bylaw #5 – 2010 is hereby repealed.
