Reminders

- **2023 Property Taxes** on due on December 31st, all unpaid taxes will be subject to a 10% penalty as of January 1, 2024.
- All **Utility Bill Arrears** are due by December 31st (not including December Utility Bill), any outstanding arrears may be transferred to your Tax Roll.
- All **Waste Transfer Station Invoices** are due as of December 31st, we are sending a statement of outstanding charges with this month's Utility Bill. Outstanding charges may be transferred to your Tax Roll and/or you may be restricted from using the Waste Transfer Station until all bills are paid in full.
Invoices would have been given to you at the Waste Transfer Station, at the time you dropped your items off. If you require a copy, please contact the Town Office.
