2026 PET LICENSES ARE DUE

Bylaw 2019-1 states that “Every person residing in the Town of Elrose, being the Owner of a dog or cat three (3) months old or older shall obtain a license for the dog or cat from the Town Office for the purpose of registering the dog or cat”

“Licence Fees shall become due on January 1st of each year or at any time during the year immediately upon a person becoming an owner of a dog or cat, and failure to do so shall constitute an offence under this Bylaw. License fees shall be:”

For Each Neutered male.....	\$ 10.00
Unneutered male.....	\$ 25.00
For Each Spayed Female.....	\$ 10.00
Unspayed Female	\$ 25.00

2026 BUSINESS LICENSES ARE DUE

Bylaw 247-1996 states that “No persons shall carry on any business, trade or calling within the municipality unless they have in their possession a valid and subsisting license.” This also includes all home based businesses. License fees shall be:

Daily	\$25.00/day
Elrose residents	\$50.00/year
Non-residents	\$100.00/year

REMINDERS:

As per Bylaw 2018-01 Snow Removal Bylaw, an owner or occupant shall not push, blade, shovel, blow or place snow that has accumulated on private property onto any sidewalk or on the adjoining sidewalk, street, or public place.

- Interest on Utility Arrears - A penalty of 2% will be added to all Utility accounts outstanding after 60 days in arrears, has been in effect since September 1, 2023.
- Speed Limit within Town Limits is 30 km
- Please watch for moving Town Equipment and stay at least 15 metres back.
