Business Licenses are Due for 2020

Bylaw #247-1996 states that "No persons shall carry on any business, trade or calling within the municipality unless they have in their possession a valid and subsisting license." This also includes all home based businesses. License fees shall be:

Daily	\$25.00/day
Elrose residents	\$50.00/year
Non-residents	\$100.00/year

****If you see any out of town business working in Town please inquire with them if they have purchased their Business License from the Town Office. Thank you.****

Pet Licenses due for 2020

Bylaw #2019-1 states that “Every person residing in the Town of Elrose, being the Owner of a dog or cat three (3) months old or older shall obtain a license for the dog or cat from the Town Office for the purpose of registering the dog or cat”

“Licence Fees shall become due on January 1st of each year or at any time during the year immediately upon a person becoming an owner of a dog or cat, and failure to do so shall constitute an offence under this Bylaw. License fees shall be:”

For Each Neutered male..... \$ 10.00
Unneutered male..... \$ 25.00
For Each Spayed Female..... \$ 10.00
Unspayed Female \$ 25.00

Just a reminder:

- Outstanding Utility Bills (not including December) and invoices that remained unpaid as of December 31, 2019 were transferred to your Property Taxes. A 10% penalty will be levied on all unpaid Property Taxes on January 1, 2020.
- **Snow Removal** – As per Bylaw 1-2018, snow cannot be shoveled/blown or dumped into the streets, therefore, for both residents and businesses any excess snow can be taken to the north side of the rodeo grounds or to the compost site.

TOWN OF ELROSE PUBLIC NOTICE

Public notice is hereby given that the Council of the Town of Elrose intends to adopt Bylaw No. 2018-8, the Official Community Plan and Bylaw No. 2018-9, the Zoning Bylaw, and Bylaw No. 2019-05, the development Fee Bylaw, under the provisions of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, to provide land use management and encourage sustainable development of the community.

INTENT:

The proposed bylaws are being adopted to provide long term land use and infrastructure management and community development in the Town and to encourage intermunicipal cooperation with neighbouring communities.

AFFECTED LANDS:

The Bylaws apply to all lands within the corporate boundaries of the Town of Elrose.

REASON:

The reason for adopting the bylaws is outlined in the intent and Council believes that the adoption of land use bylaws will provide better direction to developers and residents and show the long term commitment to responsible management of infrastructure and community resources.

PUBLIC INSPECTION:

Any person may inspect the bylaw at the Town of Elrose office between 9:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. on Monday to Friday excluding statutory holidays. Copies are available at cost.

PUBLIC HEARING:

Council will hold a public hearing on January 14, 2020 at 7:30 pm in Council Chambers at the Town of Elrose office building located at 101 Main Street in Elrose, SK to hear any person or group that wants to comment on the proposed bylaw. Council will also consider written comments received at the hearing or delivered to the undersigned at the municipal office before the hearing.
