

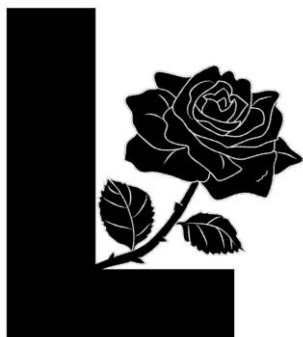

Reminders

- **Yard Maintenance** – As per Bylaw 2018-4 we ask that everyone please keep your property cleaned up, this includes the boulevard in front of your property and your property up to the alley. Grass cutting, trimming of trees that overhang sidewalks and alleyways; are some of the maintenance required.

Please do not dispose of grass clippings etc.. in the alley or carts, these can be taken to the compost pile and trees can be taken to the Transfer Station. Thank you.

- **Southern Saskatchewan 2023 Official Vacation Guides** are available at the Town Office.
- **Waste and Recycle cart pick up** – One side pick up has began, please remember when placing carts out to move them out quite far from the boulevard (10 feet from center of street) or they will not be picked and please place them 3 feet away from other carts, parked vehicles etc...

- **Building Applications and Permits** – before beginning a project please make sure to fill out and submit your building application to the Town of Elrose.

Building Permits

Not required:

- Fences – rules regarding set backs must be followed
- Driveways and parking lots, sidewalks
- Painting, decorating, laying carpet and general maintenance
- Replacement using the same materials and not affecting structural, electrical or mechanical systems (roofing, siding, windows)
- Accessory buildings (garden sheds, tool sheds) not greater than 100 square feet in area (limit one per property)
- Swimming pools and hot tubs less than 600 mm in depth
- Utility or transportation systems located on a street or public right of way
- Signs, unless attached to a building
- Operations equipment and appliances that are not part of the electrical and mechanical systems for the building.

Required:

- New building construction
- Garages and carports
- Decks
- Swimming pools and hot tubs (in locations that have applicable bylaws)
- Mobile homes
- Renovations, alterations and additions to an existing building
- Demolition of an existing building
- Relocation of an existing building
- Basement development in a dwelling unit
- Fireplaces, wood stoves and heaters
- Retaining walls
- Change of use or occupancy of a building
- Work to remedy an unsafe condition or fire official's order
- Temporary buildings
- Communication aerials and towers
