## Rodeo Grounds Free Outdoor Storage

The Town of Elrose requires all residents who presently store or would like to store their recreational vehicles, camper trailers and boats in the future at the North-East corner of the rodeo grounds to register and sign an annual waiver.

Privately owned and properly licensed recreation vehicles and camper trailers may be parked on the street shoulder in residential areas from May 1 to September 15 of each year provided that they are parked adjacent to the owner's property.

(Traffic Bylaw No. 2020-04, section 3.4).

There is no cost to the residents of the Town of Elrose for this storage
