## **Rodeo Grounds Free Outdoor Storage**

The Town of Elrose requires all residents who presently store or would like to store their recreational vehicles, camper trailers and boats in the future at the North-East corner of the rodeo grounds to register and sign an annual waiver.

1. Privately owned and properly licensed (insured) recreational vehicles, camper trailers and boats may be parked in the north-east section of the Rodeo Grounds.
2. Please register and sign this waiver annually at the Town Office.
3. A four foot section around the vehicles etc. must be mowed and maintained by the owner.
4. Privately owned and properly licensed recreation vehicles and camper trailers may be parked on the street shoulder in residential areas from May 1 to September 15 of each year provided that they are parked adjacent to the owner's property. (Traffic Bylaw No. 2020-04, section 3.4).
5. The Town of Elrose takes no responsibility for any damage to or theft of stored items.
6. There is no cost to the residents of the Town of Elrose for this storage

### **Town of Elrose Bylaw Reminders:**

1. **Parking on the wrong side of the street** – “No operator of a vehicle shall park the said vehicle with it's left-hand side to the curb, except on one way streets.” (Bylaw No. 2020-04, 3. (2) j)
2. **Duty to maintain yards, boulevards, and property adjacent to the alley** – “The owner or occupant of a property shall cut, prune, trim, clear or remove or cause to be cut, pruned, trimmed, cleared or removed any overgrown tree branches, shrubs, or bushes; and further ensure that all grass or weeds higher than 15 centimeters (6 inches) on the property or on any boulevard adjoining the property and adjacent to the alley is cut.” (Bylaw No. 2018-4, 6.)

### **WATER BILLS**

Due to the threat of a mail strike again:

#### **Have you considered setting up E-Bills for your Water & Sewer Account Monthly Bills?**

The Town of Elrose does offer this service to everyone and if you are interested, please phone the Town Office at 306-378-2202 to ask how to get it set-up so you can receive your Utility Billing.

You must have a current e-mail address.

If you prefer, you can send the Town of Elrose an e-mail ([townofelrose@sasktel.net](mailto:townofelrose@sasktel.net)) notifying the Office you would like to be set up and just write a note in the e-mail, giving your name/address so we can attach it to the correct Utility Billing.

The other option is to stop at the Town Office on Tuesday to Friday from 8:00 am. to 12:30 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. and pick up your Water Bill in person if the strike occurs.
