### GARBAGE/RECYCLING CART PICK UP

Beginning **NOVEMBER 1<sup>st</sup>** waste and recycle carts will go back to two-sided pick up. Please place your cart out in front of your home and make sure it is out at least 10 feet from the center of the street. Two-sided street cart pick up will continue until March.

**Carts that are not placed out far enough will NOT be picked up**

### REMINDERS:

#### FALL CLEANUP

Please remember that when you are cleaning up your yard this Fall all tree/bush branches must be taken to the Waste Transfer Station. Leaves, grass clippings and garden waste can go to the compost pile. **No plastic bags please.**

As per Bylaw 2020-04 Traffic Bylaw, **please remove all trailers from the streets and alleys.** They should have been removed off the streets by September 15, 2025. If you need a place to park your trailers, they can be put in the rodeo grounds in line with the other trailers. Come to the Town Office and sign an annual waiver for your recreational vehicles, camper trailers and boats.

**Interest on Utility Arrears** - A penalty of 2% will be added to all Utility accounts outstanding after 60 days in arrears, effective September 1, 2023.

**Speed Limit** within Town Limits is 30 km/hr.

Bylaw # 1 – 2018 Removal of Snow and Ice

### **DUTY TO CLEAR SIDEWALKS**

5. The owner or occupant of adjoining property, shall clear or remove or cause to be cleared or removed all snow or ice or other loose debris from any sidewalk adjoining the property within twenty-four (24) hours of the time when the snow, ice or other loose debris was formed or deposited thereon.

### **CLEARING ONTO ROADWAY RESTRICTION**

7. An owner or occupant shall not push, blade, shovel, blow or place snow that has accumulated on private property onto any sidewalk, street or public place.
