Rodeo Grounds Free Outdoor Storage

The Town of Elrose requires all residents who presently store or would like to store their recreational vehicles, camper trailers and boats in the future at the North-East corner of the rodeo grounds to register and sign an annual waiver.

1. Privately owned and properly licensed (insured) recreational vehicles, camper trailers and boats may be parked in the north-east section of the Rodeo Grounds.
2. Please register and sign this waiver annually at the Town Office.
3. A four foot section around the vehicles etc. must be mowed and maintained by the owner.
4. Privately owned and properly licensed recreation vehicles and camper trailers may be parked on the street shoulder in residential areas from May 1 to September 15 of each year provided that they are parked adjacent to the owner's property. (Traffic Bylaw No. 2020-04, section 3.4).
5. The Town of Elrose takes no responsibility for any damage to or theft of stored items.
6. There is no cost to the residents of the Town of Elrose for this storage

Interest on Utility Arrears - A penalty of 2% will be added to all Utility accounts outstanding after 60 days in arrears.

Town of Elrose Bylaw No. 2025 – 03 has been updated:

Accepted Waste Materials (No Charge if Disposed/Sorted Correctly):

- Bagged household waste
- Metal – must be put in the metal pile
- Clean Wood – must be put into the wood pile
- Branches and trees – must be cut into three foot lengths and put into the wood pile

- Vehicle and/or Tires (including Bicycle Tires)
- Recyclables such as paper, cardboard
- Animal Manure (feces) or liquid waste
- Animals (deceased) or slaughterhouse waste
- Grain or screenings
- Chemical, herbicide or pesticide products or containers
- Petroleum waste including oil filters, oily rags, oil containers
- All Electronics (take to Sarcan)
- Hazardous waste or radioactive materials
- Paint, paint thinner, or paint remover cans
- Propane Tanks
- Treated Lumber must go in the bins
