## *Reminders*

---

- **Water Rate Increase** – now in effect, as of August 1st monthly water rates were increased as per the following:

	<b>NEW Rate</b>	<b>OLD Rate</b>
For water usage up to 1,000 gallons	\$46.00	\$45.00
For each additional 1,000 gallons	\$14.00	\$13.00

- **Interest on Utility Arrears** - A penalty of 2% will be added to all Utility accounts outstanding after 60 days in arrears, effective September 1, 2023.

- **Property Tax Discount – 3% until September 30, 2023** - September is the last month to take advantage of the 3% discount on the municipal portion of your property Taxes.
- **Waste and Recycle Carts** – we are noticing that some carts are still not being placed out far enough from the side of the street, we have asked that Triways Disposal Services to no longer pick these carts up. Carts must be placed 10 feet from center of street, and 3 feet away from other carts/parked vehicles.
